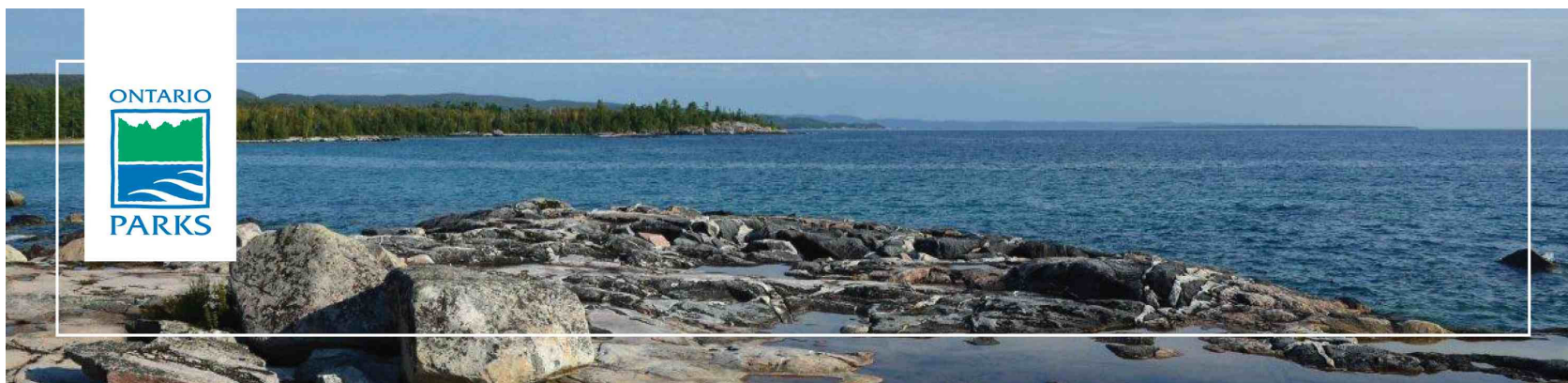

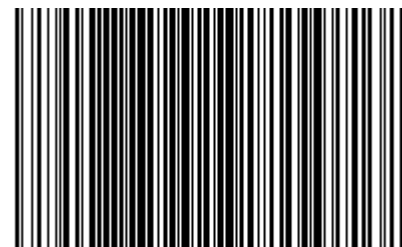

Make sure to check [Alerts in Ontario Parks](#) to ensure you are up to date on important advisories for your park.

Important Messages

- To make a change to your licence plate, please call 1-888-668-7275 or visit park staff upon arrival.
- Check in upon arrival is not required. Your confirmation letter serves as your backcountry camping permit. Your licence plate will be used to verify your permit. You are responsible for having proof of purchase while in the park either by having a digital or a printed copy of your confirmation letter or reservation number when using the backcountry.

Due to unreliable cell service, we recommend saving a screen shot of your confirmation letter to your device and ensuring you keep your device

charged during your stay.

If a discounted rate was selected at purchase, you must be able to prove eligibility.

- Backcountry sites at Frontenac are only accessible by hiking or canoeing in.
- One vehicle is included with your reservation. Additional Vehicle Permits must be purchased for all other vehicles.
- The campsite permit holder must be sixteen years of age or older.
- When backcountry camping, food and scented products must be stored in the food locker available on each site when not in use; out of sight and smell from wildlife.
- ALL camping is site specific, even in the winter. It is mandatory to stay on a designated campsite.
- Rules apply to your reservation and your camping experience. Please take the time to read and understand the [reservation rules](#) and [park rules](#). [Penalties and fees](#) will apply for changing or cancelling your reservation.
- Don't move firewood – Buy and burn firewood locally. Moving firewood from places where invasive insects and diseases have been found can be a violation of the *Plant Protection Act* and can severely damage the health of park forests. For more information about restrictions, visit the [Canadian Food Inspection Agency](#).
- Be Bear Wise – Anything that looks or smells like food, such as cooking gear, pet food, toiletries and waste can be an attractant. Be sure to keep your food and other attractants stored properly and your campsite clean. For more information about preventing bear encounters, visit [Be Bear Wise](#).
- While in the backcountry, hang your food out of reach from wildlife; at least 4 m above ground and 2 m from tree trunks. For more information visit [Prevent conflicts with wildlife | ontario.ca](#).
